Resolution #6-2000

Whereas, on February 14, 2000 the Perrier Group of America presented the New Haven Town Board with its plan for wells and a bottling plant in the Town, and;

Whereas, the citizens of the Town have raised concerns about future water availability and quality, wetland survival, traffic flow, and community growth, and;

Whereas, the Annual Town Meeting advised the town board to:

1. Hold a referendum on the proposal;
2. Send a letter to Perrier and the State of Wisconsin requesting Perrier to cease and desist all activities in the Town, and;

Whereas, sufficient time has passed for each side to present its case to the people, and;

Whereas, the referendum, held June 13, 2000 has advised, by a significant majority, that all levels of government should oppose this proposal, and;

Whereas, this issue is creating tremendous strife, worry, and expense to residents of the Town,

Now Therefore Be It Resolved that as advised by the referendum and except in case of emergency, The New Haven Town Board shall:

1. Oppose any rezoning for wells supplying water for truck or pipeline removal from the Town;
2. Oppose any rezoning for a water processing or bottling or trucking facility;
3. Publish this resolution in the Adams County Times and in the Rural Rambler;
4. Represent the Town before the County Board or any hearing of any government agency on this issue to guard the interests of the people of the Town.
5. Respectfully request that all higher levels of our government of, by and for the people abide by and accede to the wishes of a majority of the people of the Town.

Motion by Glen Whitson, Seconded by Ken Crothers to adopt this resolution. Motion carried this 30th day of ~~June~~ ^{July}, 2000.
